RESTORATION ORDER

Whereas, recognition was granted to the institution, namely, **PRAKASH COLLEGE OF EDUCATION, THALTEJ, DIST. AHMEDABAD** under section 14 of NCTE Act, 1993 for conducting B.Ed. (Girls) course of one year duration with an annual intake of 70 students vide order No. WRC/5-6/2K/11831-836 dt. 29.10.2000 from the academic session 2000-2001 was subsequently restored vide order no. WRC/313006/117th/2009/55289-55292 dt. 08.05.2009 with an annual intake of 100 students from the session 2009-2010.

2. And whereas, after the promulgation of NCTE (Recognition, Norms and Procedure) Regulations, 2014 vide notification dt. 28.11.2014, **PRAKASH COLLEGE OF EDUCATION TRUST, MOTIBHAI R. PATEL EDUCATIONAL CAMPUS NR. CAMBAY FIVE STAR HOTEL, GULAB TOWER ROAD, AHMEDABAD GUJARAT - 380054** offering B.Ed. course was informed via email/public notice to submit a duly notarized affidavit as an acceptance of the NCTE Regulations, 2014 by the institution.

3. And whereas, after the receipt of affidavit dt. 19.01.2015 from the institution, a revised recognition order no. WRC/313006/2015/143541-548 dt. **31.05.2015** was issued to the institution for conducting B.Ed. Programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic units of 50 students each) from session 2015-16 subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned here in before 31.10.2015.

4. And whereas, the matter was placed before the WRC in its 277th Meeting held on June 29th - 30th 2017 and the committee decided to issue show cause notice dt. 04.07.2017 to the institution.


5. And whereas, the reply dt. 24.07.2017 submitted by the institution, and the matter was placed before the WRC in its 317th meeting held on 28th and 30th Sept 2020 to verify the compliance of NCTE Regulations, 2014 and the Committee decided to restore the institution with an annual intake of 100 students (Two basic Units) from the date of issue of the order.

6. And whereas, the matter was again placed for rectify the 317th WRC committee decision in its 319th Meeting held on 20th and 21st October 2020 and the committee decided as follows:-

"The committee considered the reply of the institution 24.07.2017 and decided that the institution has complied with all the requirements laid down in NCTE Regulations. Hence, recognition of the institution be restored for B.Ed. course with an annual intake of 50 students (One Unit) from the date of issue of the order."

7. Now Therefore, the recognition granted to the institution for conducting B.Ed. course has been restored as per decision of the WRC in its 319th meeting and institution is permitted to continue the existing B.Ed. course of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 seats (one basic unit of 50 seats) from the date of issue of this order.

8. The institution shall continuously adhere the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended time to time and any deviation from it shall be liable for action, against the institution, as stipulated under NCTE Act, Rules and NCTE Regulations.


